On May 4, 2010 a recall was issued on several common over-the-counter infant and children's medications. The products recalled include some types of **Children's Motrin, Children's Tylenol, Children's Zyrtec, and Children's Benadryl**. The recall was issued by McNeil Consumer Healthcare, in consultation with the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
